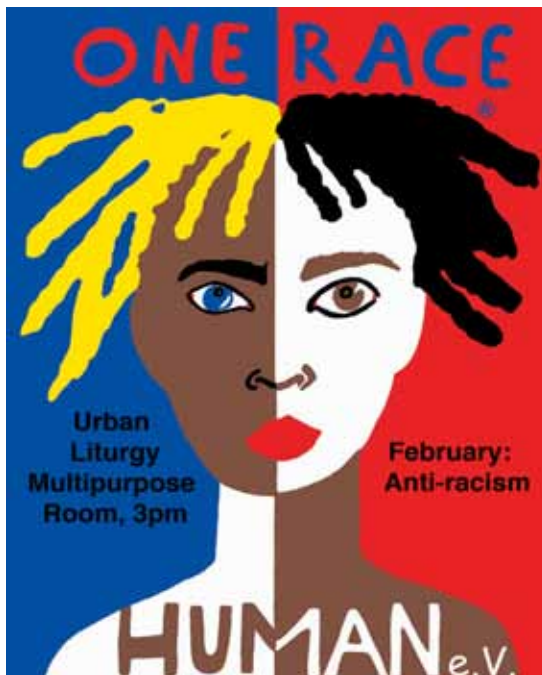

CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Every February Americans observe Black History Month, a time set aside to celebrate the contributions that African Americans have made to American history. In the next few weeks we will share a fact about the history of the observance.

The precursor to Black History Month was created in 1926 when historian Carter G. Woodson and the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History announced the second week of February to be "Negro History Week." Woodson chose the second week of February to coincide with the birthdays of Abraham Lincoln, the author of the Emancipation Proclamation, and of Frederick Douglass, an early African-American abolitionist.

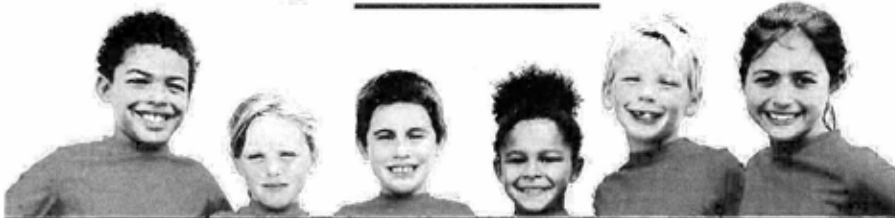
