When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, “Will you give me a drink?” The Samaritan woman said to him, “You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?” (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.) **Jesus answered her, “If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water.” The woman said to him, “Sir, give me this water so that I won’t get thirsty and have to keep coming here to draw water.”** He told her, “Go, call your husband and come back. “I have no husband,” she replied. Jesus said to her, “You are right. The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband.” “Sir,” the woman said, “I can see that you are a prophet. “I know that Messiah” (called Christ) “is coming.
