◆ **Tithe: Adventist Pastoral Support to Southern California Conference**

For every \$ 250,000 in contributions to Tithe, a congregation receives one full-time pastor from our local conference. Glendale City Church receives two full-time pastors. All donations to Tithe are sent to the conference to pay pastoral and administrative salaries, including those of our two pastors, Todd Leonard and Mike Kim.¹

FOOTNOTES

1. Annual salary for a full-time conference pastor is approximately \$73,000 + benefits
2. These local staff positions receive some of their funding from Endowment Fund
3. This expense represents a temporary five-year budget increase to cover the \$ 35,000 in installation fees for new fiberoptic internet & VOIP telephone service.
4. Church improvements are funded from the Endowment Fund and special gifts
5. Our congregations that worship in different languages cover their own ministry expenses. Endowment Fund gave \$ 20,000 towards Pastor Vigen's salary in 2018/19
6. Our worship's Lamb's Offering covers most of our Student Assistance commitment
7. Offerings collected during this time cover our non-food Marketplace expenses
8. Both concert series are almost completely funded by donations and grants
9. In addition to this small budgeted amount, we collect four offerings a year to help members in financial crisis. Contact the church office if you need assistance.
